1. What were the findings/results in 3-5 bullets

Objectives:

- Estimate the cost of the inSCALE intervention
- Estimate the cost of the implementation of ICCM in Mozambique
- Estimate the cost-effectiveness of the inSCALE intervention package
 - Cost per appropriately treated case in the intervention arm compared to control arm
 - Cost per APE in post at the end of the trial in the intervention arm compared to control arm
- Estimate the cost of ICCM implementation at scale-up
