Key progress in past quarter:

- Membership has grown to 136, a 50% increase in three months
- Three Sub-Groups formed - (1) Respiratory Rate Timers, (2) Pulse Oximetry & Oxygen Therapy, (3) Antibiotics - chaired by INSPIRELiving, University of British Columbia and USAID respectively. 6 calls held in last quarter
- UNICEF respiratory rate Target Product Profile on track for September release
- Malaria Consortium 4-country pneumonia diagnostic field trials initiated
- GSK Healthcare Innovation Award announced
- 4 Members make commitments to Every Newborn Action Plan
- 5 Members awarded Saving Lives at Birth Round IV grants
