

## Pneumonia Flowchart

Ask the caregiver:  
“Does the child have cough or difficult breathing?”

YES

Ask: “For how long?”  
If cough lasted more than 2 weeks: refer child to PHU.

THEN

Ask and check:	Look:
- “Is the child able to drink or breastfeed?” unconscious.	- See if child is sleepy or
- “Does the child vomit everything?” now.	- See if the child is convulsing
- “Has the child had convulsions?”	- Look for chest in-drawing

YES

- Refer to PHU urgently.
- Tell caregiver to give small amount of liquid frequently or continue breastfeeding while on the way if possible.

Look, listen, feel  
Use ARI timer to count the breaths in one minute.

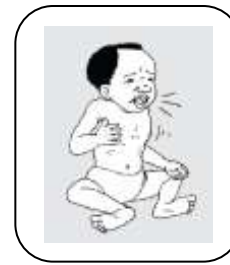
- Child 2 months to 11 months:  
50 breaths or above = fast breathing
- Child 12 months up to 5 years:  
40 breaths or above = fast breathing

NO

YES

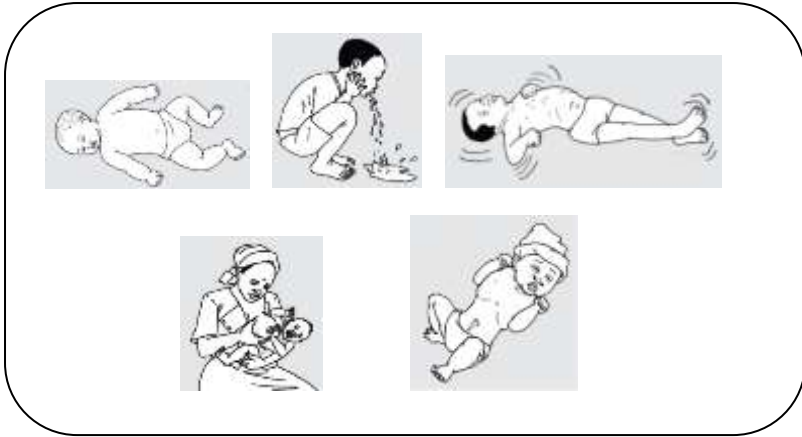
- Refer child 0-2 months to PHU.
- Give Cotrimoxazole for 5 days according to age (3-59 months).
- Soothe the throat and relieve the cough with a safe remedy.
- Advise caregiver when to return immediately.
- Follow-up in 1 day.

# Pneumonia Flowchart

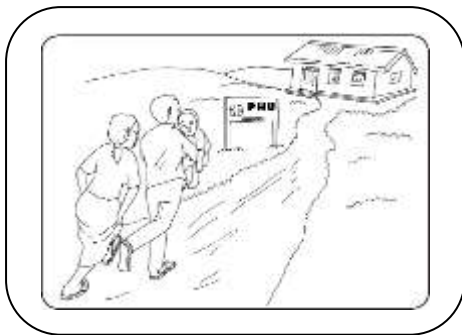


1. **ASK** "What problem is the child having?  
Caregiver says "cough" or breathing problems.

2. **ASK** and **LOOK** for danger signs.
