POLITICAL WILL

iCCM should be an extension of the PHC – MoH (iCCM Task Force/Mal-RMNCAH)

- Increased advocacy to state government for ownership and prioritization of PHC package of interventions including iCCM– MoH/NPHCDA
- Supply chain
 - Government to create budget line to ensure consistent iCCM commodities (procurement, distribution and capacity building) in consideration of the following
 - Validate Tax on antimalarial and Amox DT FG
 - Engagement of private sector for distribution MoH/NPHCDA
 - External TA needed
- Investments in Service delivery
 - Develop investment case for iCCM (mapping and needs assessment) MoH/NPHCDA
 - External TA needed

STRATEGIC USE OF INFORMATION Operationalize Community HMIS (DHIS2)

- Scale up CHMIS

- Use data for planning and decision making at PHC and community levels
 - Identifying areas of needs (HR, access)
 - *Prioritization of interventions*
 - Forecasting and quantification of commodities
 - External TA needed

BETTER GUIDANCE

- Policy issues
 - Better understanding of CHIPS as a vehicle for delivering Community Health Services including iCCM – MoH/NPHCDA
 - State government to align with the national EML MoH (Food and Drug Services)/SMoH
- Policy dissemination and use
 - Disseminate and promote the use of national guidelines and tools for iCCM at all levels MoH

LEADERSHIP AND CONRECTION

- *Develop costed operational plan for RMNCH at PHC level SMoH/SPHCDA and partners*
- Effective coordination and partnership at all levels (national, state and LGA)
 - *TWGs/committees should be functional at all levels*
 - Strengthen the capacity of leaders to understand the concept of iCCM at the state and LGA levels
 - Identify champions at all levels to promote iCCM for reducing child mortality
 - Regular demand of periodic report with action plans by higher authority (HMH, ED, HCH, ES)
 - *Mapping of partners implementing iCCM from subnational to national*
 - Where they are
 - What they do
 - Resources
 - External TA needed
