

Definition of other cause categories

Other NN (neonatal): other infectious causes, HIV/AIDS, pertussis, measles,


meningitis, malaria, diarrhoea, injuries and other NCDS

Other (group I) (Post-neonatal): Other infectious, tetanus, neonatal sepsis,

prematurity, birth asphyxia

Other (group II) (Post-neonatal): congenital anomalies, other NCDs
